


A) Please confirm this is the first and only time you answer this survey. 868 responses



<u>Interpretation</u>: From the Survey it is found that 92.9% of respondents have responded for the first and only time.




<u>Interpretation</u>: Out of total responses, 67.5% are male whereas 32.5% are female.




<u>Interpretation</u>: It is found that maximum respondents are pursuing Bachelor's degree that is 84.9% and 12.6% are pursuing Master's degree.

What subject area are you currently pursuing? 875 responses





How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 871 responses




Out of total responses, 42.8% agreed to the fact that 70 to 84% of the syllabus was covered in the class whereas 32.1% agreed that 85 to 100% of the syllabus had been covered and 19.1% agreed to 55 to 69% completion of the syllabus. According to 4.3% of the respondents 30 to 54% of the syllabus was covered and below 30% of the syllabus was covered in accordance to 1.6% of the respondents.

How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 870 responses




<u>Interpretation</u>: According to 34% of the respondents the teachers prepared for their respective subjects thoroughly, whereas 59.1% have satisfactory response to the fact. 5.3% of the respondents opted for poor preparedness of the subjects by the teachers and 0.8% of respondents choose that a few teachers have different perspective towards class preparation.






The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 873 responses




<u>Interpretation</u>: According to 40.2% teacher approach to teaching is very good and 34.1% opted for excellent teaching approach. As per 22.% teaching approach is good and 2.9% and 0.8% opted for fair and poor teaching approach of the teachers.


Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 873 responses

The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 867 responses


Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 869 responses





The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. ${\tt 865\,responses}$






Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 868 responses


The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.






Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



<u>Interpretation</u>: According to 19.6%, more than 90% of teachers use ICT tools while teaching and 34.7% choose that more than 70% of teachers use these tools. 18.7% agreed that more than 50% and less than 70% of teachers use such tools. 11.5% agreed that more than 30% and less than 49% teachers use these tools and 15.5% agreed that below 29% use these tools.
