## 1. Title of the Practice:

**Skill and Talent Advancement Programme (STAP)**

## 2. Objective of Practice:

1. To make high-quality of teaching – learning on electronic mode.
2. To train the Faculty and students to cop-up with online classes.
3. To enhance skills of the students to be fit for attaining online classes and examinations.
4. To expedite decision making ability of the students and teachers across the various regions.

## 3. The Context:

In the year 2020-21, the College was facing severe problem in conducting offline mode of teaching-learning due to Covid-19 pandemic and SOP of the Govt. of Assam. The College followed the practice of the classes on online mode. It required the workshop to expedite the decision making of e-mode teaching-learning. Faculty members were making ready to take up the online mode of teaching and able to face the classes as well as examination.

## 5. The Practice:

The College followed the SOP announced by Govt. of Assam due to Covid-19 pandemic and became complete lock-down from March, 2019 to August, 2021. During this period, faculty members were trained up to do the classes on online mode. Principal of the College, arranged a day long workshop on the practice of online mode of classes with faculty members, since all the faculty members were not accustomed with the practice of e-mode classes. Since then, the faculty members have done the classes through Google Meet and Google Class Room. Furthermore, the various departments organized webinars during these periods.

The students, specially final semester (i.e. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester) were able to face the examination on online mode conducted by Gauhati University during that period.

### 5. Achievements:

The practice was successful in doing the effective classes on online mode till the offline mode of classes was started. The online modes of classes were done till the new SOP circulated relating to offline classes. Since, September, 2021 the offline classes have been started gradually. Moreover the faculty members in association with IQAC and Principal successfully conducted several webinars in National and International level.

## 6. Problems Encountered:

The faculty members as well as students were mostly suffered from the effective learning due Network problem. Most of the students were belonging to the remote area where the network is not available. Sometimes the network was available but the speed was very slow. They were generally deprived from online mode of teaching-learning. The students who were economically poor were unable to manage smart phone in many cases also.

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
