The event was jointly organized by the college's National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit, National Cadet Corps (NCC) and Students' Union. The celebration commenced in the morning with a tree plantation drive across the college campus, promoting the importance of greenery and environmental conservation. Following the plantation programme, a special invited lecture session was held in the college auditorium on the theme, **“Restoring Nature through Biodiversity Conservation and Indigenous Knowledge.”** Miss.
