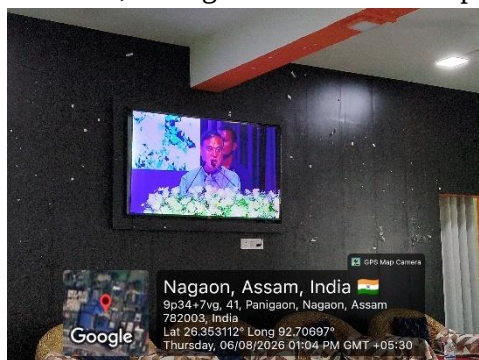


NIJUT MOINA AND NIJUT BABU SCHEME FORM DISTRIBUTION 2026 AT NAGAON G.N.D.G. COMMERCE COLLEGE

The distribution of application forms under the Assam Government's "Nijut Moina and Nijut Babu" Scheme 2026 was formally inaugurated at Nagaon G.N.D.G. Commerce College on 6th August, 2026, marking an important step towards extending the benefits of the scheme to eligible students. The scheme aims to encourage the enrolment and continuation of girl students in higher education, prevent child marriage and reduce teenage motherhood. It also seeks to safeguard the rights of children to education, health and safety by providing financial assistance to eligible students. Prior to the formal distribution of the application forms on 6th August, 2026 the college staff and students watched the **live streaming of the central distribution programme**. This was followed by the formal distribution of the application forms among eligible students at the college. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal of the college, **Dr. Mriganka Saikia**, who elaborated the objectives and significance of the Nijut Moina and Nijut Babu Scheme. He highlighted the importance of such government initiatives in promoting access to higher education, ensuring educational continuity and empowering young students. The programme was attended by the **Chief Guest, Sjt. Rana Borah, President, Khagarijan Anchalik Panchayat, Nagaon, Assam**, who formally distributed the application forms among eligible girl and boy students. Addressing the gathering, he emphasised the importance of educational support schemes in enabling students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds to pursue higher education without financial constraints. Students from the **B.Com., B.B.A. and M.Com. programmes** participated in the programme along with the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. The programme was anchored by **Prof. Aranya Jyoti Gayan, IQAC Co-ordinator & HoD, Department of Management**. The event concluded with the singing of the **National Anthem**, in which the Chief Guest, College staff and students participated.
